You are invited to book a club stand at the 28th Irish Classic and Vintage Motor Show, at Terenure College Dublin 6W, on Sunday 7 July 2019.

The grounds will be open from 8am and we ask that you to try to have all cars in place before the show opens to the public at 10am In the interest of safety we cannot have cars moving around during the show and cars arriving after 11am will not be allowed into the field and will be parked in a special area of the public car park. In the interests of public safety, and out of courtesy to the paying public, we would ask your club members to remain in the field until the show closes at 5pm. We ask that

entrants only leave earlier in the event of an emergency and that they obey the marshals instructions and yield to pedestrians at all times.

Eligible Vehicles: Veteran, vintage and classic cars, motorbikes, commercial and military vehicles over 20 years old. More recent kit cars, custom cars, sports and super cars may display as part of one marque clubs or by special arrangement only.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission. The private grounds are provided by kind permission of the Carmelite Order and note that no dogs, charcoal-fired barbecues, unapproved trading or commercial activities are permitted. Anyone in breach of these rules will be deemed to be trespassing and may be removed.

Insurance: This event is fully covered by public liability insurance, however valid insurance cover must be held by all entrants for their vehicles, as neither the organisers nor the venue owners will be held responsible for any damage to vehicles or for personal injuries or loss. We would request that each club provide at least two fire extinguishers, suitable for fuel fires, on their stand.
